1. Are there any additional costs above those listed above? **YES ...**

- **Required:** ALL guests (even 3rd & 4th) pay on-board gratuities of **\$51.80 per person** - can be pre-paid or billed to the cabin on-board acct. Also if needed, Terminal Parking is \$21/day.
- **Optional:** Travel Ins. thru Carnival is \$49 per person (includes trip cancellation, baggage, medical, emergency evacuation, and more - see www.carnival.com/about-carnival/vacation-protection.aspx for specifics).

2. Can I stay in a cabin by myself?

- You can. You will need to pay a "single supplement" charge, equal to a 2nd person cruise fare (minus the port and tax fees) since the cabins are priced based on double occupancy rates. The additional cost is **\$229 [I]; \$259 [OV]**.

3. What about having a 3rd (or 4th) traveler in the same cabin?

- You can. A limited number of "Triple" and "Quad" cabins are available. The first two guests would pay the normal pp cost. The 3rd and 4th guest in either style cabin will pay a reduced fee of \$216.64 (incl. port fees & taxes), plus the \$51.80 gratuities per person. **Note: Triple & Quad Cabins are subject to availability & require full \$150 deposits for all cabin guests in order to assign.**

4. When are payments due?

- **(1) INITIAL "HOLD" DEPOSIT** of \$25 is due by 9/30/19; **(2) REMAINING DEPOSIT BAL** [to total \$150] is due by 10/28/19; **(3) TOTAL REMAINING BALANCE** is due by 12/26/19.

5. How do I pay?

- By credit / debit card payment to Carnival. All payments for our group must be made through our travel agent, Figueroa Travel.

6. What if I have to cancel?

- Before 10/28/19 there is not penalty. After that date, a sliding cancellation fee scale means you would forfeit between 50-100% of the cruise cost.

7. Do I need a Passport?

- Passport is preferred, but a copy of birth cert. and original gov't issued photo ID is acceptable.

6. Can I go if I have arrests or convictions in my past?

- Outstanding warrants will disqualify a traveler. Additionally, some felony convictions may impact one's ability to travel internationally. Unfortunately, we cannot give the answer to this question, the traveler will have to research this question for himself based on his specific situation.
